# From the **Principal**

## Jessie Beck parents and families,

We are officially halfway through the school year. We have accomplished a lot and have much more to do before we end this year. I wanted to touch bases with you on a few items.

The first is school safety. We have formed a small committee made up of staff and a small group of parents. This committee has met once and made recommendations as to increasing the safety in our school. We will continue to revisit this on a regular basis and implement suggestions as appropriate. It is important that all parents and visitors realize that they must sign in at the office between the hours of 9 and 3. If a child arrives at school after 9:00, parents will be asked to leave them at the front doors. This is both for safety and to help protect the classroom from disruptions that take away from students learning time.

The second bit of information I need to share with you is that Jessie Beck was recognized recently as a **5 star school**. The district is moving to a very different accountability model looking at many different areas of performance. Student growth plays heavily into this as does: proficiency, parent involvement and student engagement. Congratulations to our amazing staff and talented students on their accomplishment.

Finally, it is my hope that by moving to less frequent PFA meetings, we can increase our parent involvement/attendance. Please join us on **Tuesday, Feb. 12th** for our meeting. **Aaron Grossman** will be presenting on Common Core State Standards and the difference that they are making in teaching and learning. He is an expert in the field and a great asset at Jessie Beck!

Our Two Way Immersion program continues to grow and do well now into 4th grade. The TWI team has been given the opportunity to attend a national conference on bilingual education in February and we hope to bring back many great ideas. The school district will also be working with a consultant at the end of the month to analyze our programs and give us useful feedback about what we can do to make improvements. I am very excited to be having important conversations at the district level about TWI.

Thank you for all that you do to help us at school and keep the connection strong with students home. Jessie Beck is an amazing place because of our dedicated staff, present parents and attentive students. No amount of help is too small. Please be sure to keep in touch with your classroom teacher to see what you can do to help out. There is always something...



**In response to parents' preference and in collaboration with teachers and Mrs. Anderson, Faith Osgard has started coordinating our new Science Program.**

Following is a list of items needed to stock the program:

empty, washed 2 liter plastic bottles, glass jars with lids, large mixing bowls, measuring spoons, modeling clay, wire strainers, baking soda, cornstarch, vinegar, food coloring, plastic wrap, paper towels, Ziploc bags, plastic ice trays, D-size batteries, plant seeds, potting soil, large plant pots, small portable freezer, earthquake table, 20 small clear plastic bins with lids or drawer sets, any science equipment (beakers, test tubes, flasks, petri dishes, etc.).



We look forward to seeing each student's entry and to seeing you the 28th!


### Important Deadline Dates for the fair:
