



#### **Transportation:**

The weeks Beck is impacted by no transportation are listed below, so please plan accordingly. 4/11-4/15, 5/9-5/13, 6/6-6/7

Summer School will be offered again this summer. The dates are June 21st-July 14th Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. Jessie Beck will be a host site with two other elementary schools attending at Beck. Teachers will be reaching out to families of students who would benefit from in-person summer school. Once this contact has been made and parents would like their child to be signed up, our secretary will enroll he/she. This will be a great opportunity for some of our students to continue to improve their academic skills. There will also be an enrichment Summer School option where students can continue working on Dreambox and Reading A-Z.

**Register for the 2022-2023 School Year** Parents can complete the online registration form under the Infinite Campus parent portal for returning students. New students also complete the online registration using this link. School staff is always available to help with the registration process. Visit www.washoeschools.net/enroll.

**Incoming Kinder Students:** There are new age guidelines per changes approved by the Nevada Legislature for the incoming kindergarten students. For the 2022-2023 school year, children must be five years of age on or before Monday, August 15, 2022, for balanced calendar schools.

**SBAC**-Grades 3rd-6th will be April 13th-May 12th. Teachers will let you know class specific dates as it gets closer.

April 18th-State Professional Day for staff-No school, No nutrition services, No before or afterschool programs.

### CLINIC CORNER

Although the exclusion period has been shortened to 5 days, the contagious time can still last the 10 days. Which is why when your student completes their 5-day exclusion we ask that they wear a well-fitting mask upon return, day 6 through day 10. If student is not able or willing to wear a fitted mask, exclusion is 10 days. You may return day 11, if symptomatic conditions are met.

People wear masks for many reasons, not just illness or exposure. Please be kind and understanding.

Parents of 6th graders, please look for a flyer regarding the vaccination requirements for incoming 7th graders. TDaP and MCV(meningitis) are both required PRIOR to the first day of school and will be turned away if not compliant. Avoid the rush and bring in vaccine documentation to the health office and it will be entered into IC. Please contact the school nurse at J. Beck or at Swope with any questions or concerns regarding this requirement.




